 - Cat A: 5**=7; 5*=6; 5=5; 4=4; 3=3; 2=2; 1=1.
 - Cat C: A*=6; A=5; B=4; C=3; D=2; E=1.
- A Level is based on best 3 subjects.
 - A or A2 Level: A*=6, A=5, B=4, C=3, D=2, E=1.
 - AS or A1 Level: A=2.5, B=2, C=1.5, D=1, E=0.5.
- IB score is based on the complete IB diploma.
- **QUT College Merit Scholarship – for Diploma programs**
 - 25% off for first semester
 - HKDSE = 10 (best 4) / A-Level = 6 (best 3) / IB = 25 (predicted scores)
- **QUT International Talent Scholarship – for Undergraduate programs**
 - 20% off for each semester
 - HKDSE = 14 (best 4) / A-Level = 9 (best 3) / IB = 30 (predicted scores)
- **QUT International Merit Scholarship – for Undergraduate programs**
 - 25% off for each semester
 - HKDSE = 16 (best 4) / A-Level = 10 (best 3) / IB = 32 (predicted scores)
